Casting Agreements

- The Central Florida Community Arts creative team values a safe and respectful casting process
- Central Florida Community Arts publishes auditions well in advance of the audition date
- What to expect from the Central Florida Community Arts casting environment:
 - Clear communication efforts prior to the audition
 - Visible and easy to follow wayfinding and signage in and around the venue
 - In addition to the program director and leadership team, a qualified and vetted
 Central Florida Community Arts casting director will always be present in the room
 - Personalized auditions that are welcoming, encouraging and inclusive

- Video submissions are accepted with advanced approval

Deviations Per Program

- Auditions for the Community Choir and Children & Youth Arts Programs are educationbased and will provide feedback upon request
- Children & Youth Arts Programs will provide media and medical releases at auditions
- Callbacks are program specific and will be communicated at the audition
- Auditions may be group or individual audition type and requirements will be communicated in the casting notice
- Actors Equity actors are only eligible for certain shows and will need approval by AEA
- Central Florida Community Arts is committed to hosting open auditions for all programs but reserves the right to reach out to past auditionees to ensure our core value of quality
